

**CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST LUTHER GRAND VALLEY**

**BY LAW NO 96-18**

**Being a By-Law to prescribe speed limits in School Zones - 40 Kilometres per hour**

**WHEREAS** subsection 128(5) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.H.8 authorizes the Council of a municipality and the trustees of a police village,

- (a) to designate a portion of highway under its jurisdiction that adjoins the entrance to or the exit from a school and that is within 150 metres along the highway in either direction beyond the limits of the land used for the purposes of the school; and
- (b) to prescribe a rate of speed of 40 kilometres per hour for motor vehicles driven upon the portion of a highway so designated on days on which school is regularly held and prescribe the time between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at which such speed limit is effective.

**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient to prescribe a maximum speed limit of 40 kilometres per hour upon the portions of highways designated hereunder;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of East Luther Grand Valley enacts as follows:

1. The maximum rate of speed shall be 40 kilometres per hour on those portions of highways set out in Column 1 in the school zone named in Column 2 for the effective periods referred to in Column 3.

<u>Column 1</u>	<u>Column 2</u>	<u>Column 3</u>
Main Street North (Highway #25)	Grand Valley & District Public School	12 Months of the Year (On Designated School Days)

2. The penalties provided in subsection 128(14) of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this By-Law.
