

# NOTICE OF NOMINATION FOR OFFICE

Nomination Period opens on May 2, 2022 and closes at 2pm on Nomination Day, August 19, 2022.

During this period, Nominations are being accepted for the offices of:

## **Municipal Council:**

Mayor - 1 to be elected

Deputy Mayor - 1 to be elected

Councillor - 3 to be elected

## **School Boards:**

Trustee, Upper Grand District School Board (English Public) - 1 to be elected

*The Town of Mono is responsible for conducting the election for the Town of Grand Valley.*

***Nominations must be filed with the Clerk, Town of Mono.***

Trustee, Conseil scolaire Viamonde (formerly Conseil scolaire de district du Centre Sud-Ouest) (French Public) - 1 to be elected

*The City of Barrie is responsible for conducting the election for the Town of Grand Valley.*

***Nominations must be filed with the Clerk, City of Barrie.***

Trustee, Dufferin Peel Catholic District School Board (English Separate) - 1 to be elected

*The Town of Caledon is responsible for conducting the election for the Town of Grand Valley. Nominations must be filed with the City Clerk, Town of Caledon.*

Trustee, Conseil scolaire catholique MonAvenir (French Separate)- 1 to be elected

*The City of Brampton is responsible for conducting the election for the Town of Grand Valley.*

***Nominations to be filed with the City Clerk, City of Brampton.***

To run for office, you must be an eligible elector in the Town of Grand Valley. This means that you must be:

- A Canadian Citizen;
- At least 18 years of age;
- Reside in the Town, or be the owner or tenant of land in the Town, or the spouse of such owner or tenant; and
- Not prohibited from voting under any law.

Nominations may be filed in the Office of the Clerk during regular business hours Monday to Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. until August 18, 2022, and on Nomination Day, Friday, August 19, 2022 from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

Nominations must be completed on the prescribed Nomination Paper - Form 1 and accompanied by the nomination filing fee of \$200 for Mayor and \$100 for all other offices. The filing fee is payable by cash or debit. (Exact change only)

Before filing for candidacy, candidates are advised to review the [2022 Candidates' Guide for Ontario municipal council and school board elections](#). Then, candidates must complete the [Nomination Form](#) and submit it along with proof of the candidate's identity, qualifying address and Canadian citizenship to the Town of Grand Valley Municipal Office in person. The nomination paper must be signed by the candidate and may be filed in person or by an agent. If an agent files the nomination form, it must be accompanied by a piece of Government Photo Identification including address, with the signature of the candidate, and must be commissioned prior to filing with the Clerk. Nominations cannot be filed through any other means.

In the event there are an insufficient number of certified candidates to fill all positions available, nominations will be reopened for the vacant positions only on Wednesday, August 24, 2022, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and such additional nominations, if required, may be filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Town of Grand Valley.

Electors are hereby given notice that if a greater number of candidates are certified than are required to fill the said offices, voting will take place between Friday, October 14, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. to Monday, October 24, 2022 at 8:00 p.m.

No person who proposes to be a candidate may solicit or accept contributions for election purposes or incur campaign expenses until he or she has filed a nomination paper.

Nominations will be certified by 4:00 p.m. on Monday, August 22, 2022.
