



TOWN OF GRAND VALLEY SEASONAL SUMMER EMPLOYMENT PUBLIC WORKS LABOURER

The Town of Grand Valley is accepting resumes for a summer student position for the period April 29 to August 30, 2019.

Position available:

Public Works Summer Labourer – Duties will include lawn maintenance (cutting, trimming), gardening/watering, painting and assisting with cemetery maintenance and general municipal housekeeping.

This position is performed mostly outdoors, demands a higher level of physical activity and includes shoveling and some repetitive, heavy lifting.

Previous experience with push mowers, zero-turn mowers and powered line trimmers would be an asset.

CSA approved work boots and a Current Ontario Class 'G' Driver's License are required. Pending the approval of the Town's application for funding, Fall 2019 Enrollment in a qualifying Post-Secondary Education program may also be required.

Position reports to the Public Works Superintendent, working out of the Public Works Yard in Grand Valley.

A preferential resume submittal would include:

- Prior experience relative to the specific position applied for.
- Details of enrollment in a post-secondary education program for Fall 2019.
- Specific education and training information, including previous placements and references.
- Concise cover letter (under one page).

This position will work a regularly scheduled 40-hour work week. Occasional weekend work will be required for scheduled plant watering and occasional community events.
