- Enroll in our pre-authorized payment plan. Pre-Authorized Tax Payments (PAP) Program
- Call the Municipal Office at (519) 928-5652 (option 0) during regular business hours. We can accept VISA and Mastercard payments over the phone.
- Telephone or on-line banking
- At your Bank or Financial Institution
- In-person at the Municipal Office 5 Main Street North, Grand Valley, during regular business hours
- Drop box after hours located at the Municipal Office 5 Main Street North, Grand Valley (do not place cash in the drop box)
