### Conditions:

1. Mud tracking or dust nuisance is prohibited. Any accumulation of debris must be cleared from the road and/or shoulders immediately. If at any time the Town finds tracking or dust to be excessive, this permit will be revoked.
2. Permit valid during daylight hours, Monday to Friday only, excluding statutory holidays.
3. A copy of this permit must be carried on all delivery vehicles and a copy kept on site for inspection.
4. The permit holder accepts responsibility for any and all damages and resulting additional maintenance required to the haul route as a result of the above works.
5. At certain times during spring thaw, any amount of heavy vehicular traffic will be unacceptable due to the likelihood of excessive road damage. As such the Town retains the right to rescind this agreement temporarily with no prior notice and normal seasonal restrictions will be in place.
6. Whenever possible, deliveries should be scheduled before 11:00 a.m. to take advantage of any overnight frost.
7. Road conditions are monitored by the Town. The permit holder will be notified of any change in status of this permit as soon as possible should roads show evidence of deterioration.
